Performing A CNS VS Web Re-Test

About the Re-Test Function

Occasionally a patient will experience an issue during their assessment (quitting, computer failure etc.) or will have a results that triggered an invalid score in their report. The Re-Test function provides users with the ability to create and customize a new testing session for a patient without using another assessment credit. Often, users will create Re-Tests for only one or a few normed cognitive subtests. Patients are eligible for retesting within 1-week of their initial assessment.

Steps to Perform A Web Re-Test

- 1 Click on the 'CNSVS Online' button in the bottom right corner of the CNS Vital Signs homepage. (www.cnsvs.com)
- **2** Select the 'Computer' icon to perform a neurocognitive assessment.
- **3** Enter your username and password and press 'Login'.
- **4** Select 'Retest' to see a list of patients eligable for retesting. Note: Patients IDs are eligable for retesting for seven days following their most recent test.
- **5** Select one of the Patient IDs from the list and then press the 'Retest' button.
- **6** On the next screen, use the dropdown menus to select the 'Birth Date' for that patient.
- 7 Customize the assessment configuration settings for the patient's Re-Test and press 'Begin Assessment' when the patient is ready to start their new testing session.
